

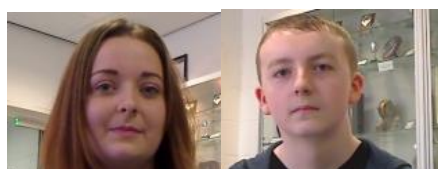


SIXTH FORM – MONTHLY NEWSLETTER
